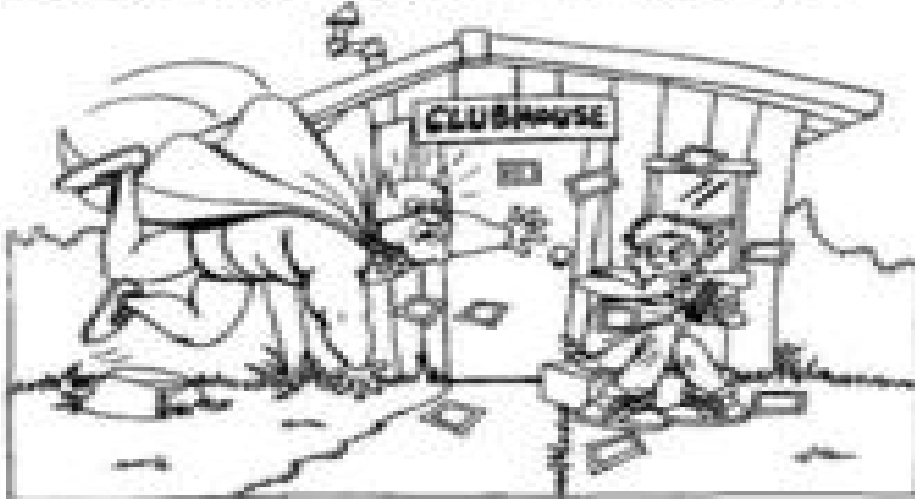


### Subject Verb Agreement

If a sentence has a singular subject then it must have a singular verb.  
If a sentence has a plural subject then it must have a plural verb.
