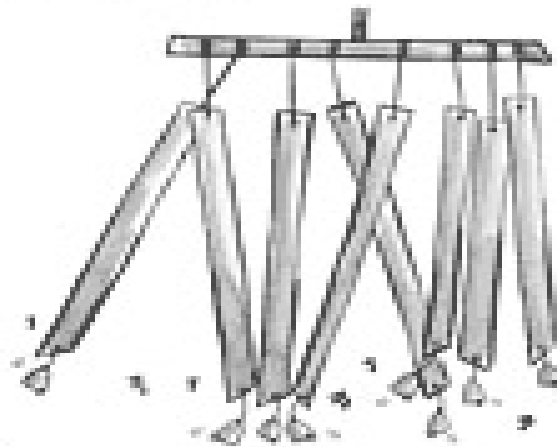
Poem in three lines:
