

## How can I match service learning to a career cluster?

<b>16 Career Clusters</b>	<b>Service learning can introduce employability skills and network students to agencies, business, industry and community organizations that might lead to internships, jobs, or post-secondary scholarship opportunities while giving back to the community.</b>
Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources	Cincinnati Zoo, Civic Garden Center neighborhood gardens, LaBoiteaux Woods, Northside Greenspace, SPCA, People working cooperatively, Cincinnati Park District
Architecture and Construction	OTR Housing Network, Habitat for Humanity, Building Value
Arts, AV Technology and Communications	Media Bridges, Freedom Center, build a website for a community group, ArtWorks
Business Management and Administration	Volunteer with Parks and Recreation to plan summer programs for children, write a business plan for a non-profit
Education and Training	Kid's café, neighborhood libraries, tutoring, head start, Peaslee Homework Room, community centers
Finance	Assist a neighborhood group with the budget for a grant proposal
Government and Public Administration	Volunteer for Youth commissions, voter registration, League of Women Voters or work for ballot issue and candidates,
Health Science	Candy striper at a hospital, health agency, battered women shelter, nursing home, health fair, neighborhood clinic
Hospitality & Tourism	Serve meals at the Drop Inn Center, Ronald McDonald House
Human Services	Volunteer with service clubs, retirement communities, Easter Seals, Special Olympics, Kids' Cafe
Information Technology	Make a website for a community organization, volunteer with Black Data Processors, teach computer skills at a community center or church
Law, Public Safety and Security	Explorer Post Law Enforcement activities, civil air patrol cadet program, police cadet program, Citizens on Patrol
Manufacturing	Volunteer at a Sheltered workshop
Marketing, Sales & Service	Design a PSA for a community group, design a brochure, poster or PSA for a community Farm Market
Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics	Volunteer at the Children's Museum, teach computer skills at a community center, tutor for math and science OAT/OGT
Transportation, & Distribution	Work at MOBO bike co-op, assist on ACCESS vans
