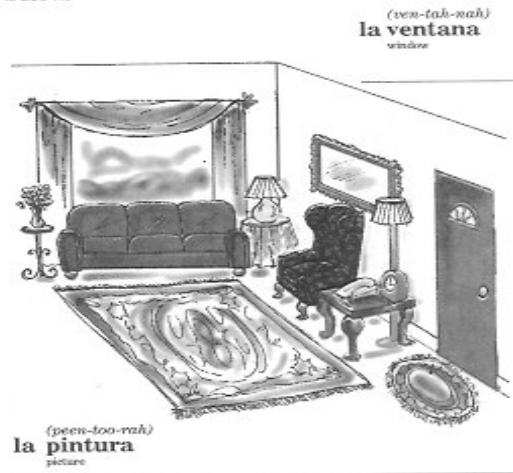


Look Around You

Before you proceed with this Step, situate yourself comfortably in your living room. Now look around you. Can you name the things that you see in this ^(kwar-toh) **cuarto** in Spanish? You can probably guess ^(lahm-pah-rah) **la lámpara** and maybe even ^(soh-fah) **el sofá**. Let's learn the rest of them. After practicing these **palabras** out loud, write them in the blanks below.

You will notice that the correct form of **el** or **la** is given ^(kohn) **con** each noun. This tells you whether the noun is masculine (**el**) or feminine (**la**). Now open your ^(lee-brah) **libro** to the sticky labels on page 17 and later on page 35. Peel off the first 11 labels **y** proceed around ^(kwar-toh) **el cuarto**, labeling these items in your home. This will help to increase your **español palabra** power easily. Don't forget to say each **palabra** as you attach the label.

Now ask yourself, "¿Dónde está ^(lahm-pah-rah) **la lámpara**?" **y** point at it while you answer, "^(ah-see) **Allí está** **la lámpara**." Continue on down the list above until you feel comfortable with these new **palabras**.
