It's = it is. Its is possessive. There is a place. Their is possessive. They're = they are.

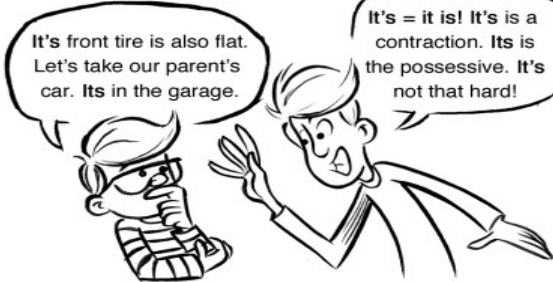


Hey! **Its** a nice day to go to the zoo!
