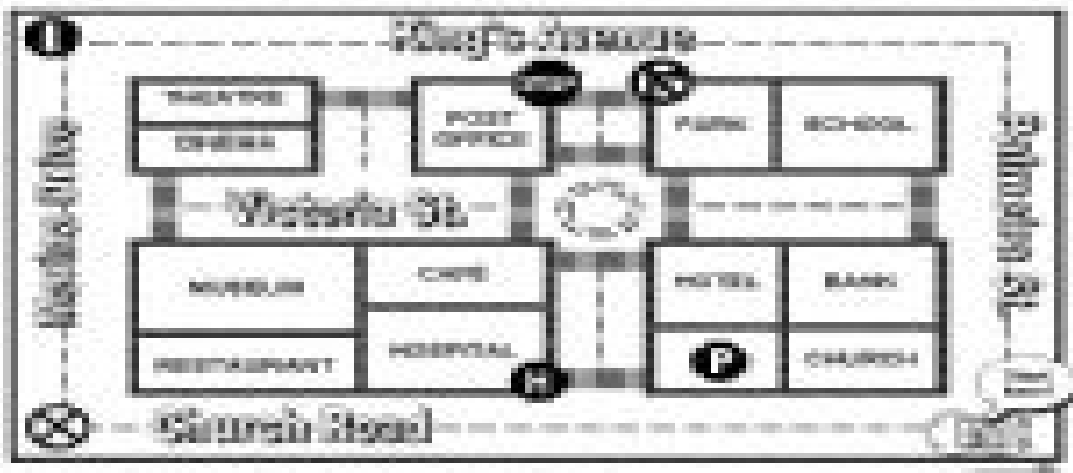


GIVING DIRECTIONS



- 1. Look at the map. Follow the directions and write sentences.**
- Go straight ahead, left, the hospital and then turn right, then along Market Street and turn right into Church Street. Take the second turning on the right. Cross the street. Turn left at the corner.
 - Go up Victoria Street, across the big roundabout, left. Go past Museum Street, across right, turn straight ahead. At the end of the road, across it is the school.
 - Go straight ahead. Turn the left turning on the right. Go along the road and turn left. Stop. What's on your left?
 - Go straight ahead. Take the first turning on the right and then right again. Cross the road and go into the city. Turn left and walk along the path. Where are you?
 - Go down Church Street and turn right into Market Street. Go across the street and stop. What's across the road?
 - Go up Victoria Street and turn left into Church Street. Take the first turning on the right and go straight ahead, past the post office.
