| 1. Harry S. Truman | 33rd President of the United States |
| 2. Elizabeth Wallace Truman | First Lady, nicknamed Bess as a child |
| 3. Alben W. Barkley | Vice President to Harry S. Truman |
| 4. Democratic | Harry S. Truman's political party |
| 5. Lamar, Missouri | Harry S. Truman's birthplace, born on May 8, 1884 |
| 6. Potsdam Conference | A conference held in Potsdam in the summer of 1945 where Truman, Stalin, and Churchill drew up plans for the administration of Germany and Poland after World War II ended |
| 7. Atom Bomb | A nuclear weapon in which enormous energy is released by nuclear fission |
| 8. Cold War | A state of political hostility that existed from 1945 until 1990 between countries led by the Soviet Union and countries led by the United States |
| 9. Truman Doctrine | President Truman's policy of providing economic and military aid to any country threatened by communism or totalitarian ideology |
| 10. Marshall Plan | A United States program of economic aid for the reconstruction of Europe (1948-1952) |
| 11. Berlin Airlift | Airlift in 1948 that supplied food and fuel to citizens of west Berlin when the Russians closed off land access to Berlin |
