



How to Draw a Treble Clef, One Line

1. To draw a treble clef in one motion, create a spiral upward and to the right that begins at or just below the second (from bottom) staff line.
2. The spiral will continue until it reaches the first (bottom) staff line, then curve back up to the second staff line.
3. Continue the spiral up to the fourth (second from top) staff line, curving the shape to resemble the middle of the design.
4. Loop the line up past the fifth (top) staff line and back down to the fourth staff line.
5. Bring the line straight down or on a slight angle, extending it beyond the first staff line.
6. Finish the treble clef with a curve or loop towards the right and inward.
7. Add a solid dot at the tip of the base curve and then try a few on your own in the extra space provided.
