Course Description: Journey into the Wardrobe with Lucy, Edmund, Susan, and Peter. As we read the book, we will learn more about the fantasy genre, determine why this story fits into that genre, and be on the lookout for the Biblical truths hidden in this classic tale. We'll be sure and have some fun throughout our adventure. By the end of the semester, the students will also have a completed lapbook. There will be at least one take-home assignment.

Target Age: 4th-5th grades

Week 1: Chapters 1-2: Fantasy & Truth (Philippians 4:8)

Week 2: Chapters 3-4: desert (Genesis 31:4), great Pharaohs, tasting Turkish Delight

Week 3: Chapters 5-6: motives (Lute 6:45), reputation, logic exercises

Week 4: Chapters 7-8: the prophecies, Edmund's eyes (Matthew 6:22-23), statue game

Week 5: Chapters 9-10: selfishness (Philippians 2:3-8), create story statues

Week 6: Chapters 11-12: courage & duty (Orange Marmalade Balls)

Week 7: Chapters 13-14: keeping your eyes on Jesus (Matthew 14:21-24), evaluate this book as a fantasy

Week 8: Chapters 15-16: The Resurrection

Week 9: Chapter 17: lapbook construction
