- \_\_\_\_\_ Consists of skin, hair, and nails for protection.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Produces and delivers sperm.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Breaks down food into nutrients for absorption by the body.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A system that moves your bones.
- \_\_\_\_\_ This system sends out chemical messages to regulate body functions (the ovaries are in this system).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Helps you get rid of harmful germs and returns leaked fluids to blood vessels.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Provides a frame to support and protect body parts.
