

CELL CYCLE CUT & PASTE

Instructions:

1. Cut out each of the cells which represent a phase in the cell cycle.
2. Place them on a separate piece of paper in a circular manner in the correct order.
3. Predict what will happen to the cell during cytokinesis. Draw a picture in the box provided and place it into correct order on your separate piece of paper.
4. Paste your pieces onto the paper
5. Label the phases: interphase, prophase, metaphase, anaphase, telophase, and cytokinesis.
6. Label the parts of the cell that have lines attached to them.
7. Label your finished product with "Plant Cell Cell Cycle"
