

### WORD ORDER OF ADJECTIVES

Adjectives like *new/large/round/wooden* are **FACT** adjectives.

(They give us *factual information* about age, size, colour, etc.)

Adjectives like *nice/beautiful/tidy* are **OPINION** adjectives.

(They tell us *what somebody thinks of something or somebody*.)

**OPINION** adjectives usually go before **FACT** adjectives:

a nice long summer holiday,                      an interesting young man,  
a delicious hot vegetable soup,                      a beautiful large round wooden table

Sometimes we use two or more **FACT** adjectives. We put **FACT** adjectives in this order:

Numbers usually go before adjectives: six large eggs                      the second big shock

**FIRST, NEXT** and **LAST** most often go before *one, two, three, etc.*

the first three days                      my last two jobs

It is unnatural to use more than two or three adjectives together in one phrase.
