

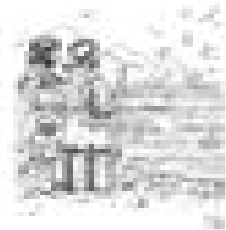

1. Louisiana Purchase: Territory in the western United States purchased 1803 for \$15 million.
2. Pacific: Lewis and Clark went to find a way across the new land to this ocean.
3. Expedition: An organized group of people undertaking a journey for a particular purpose.
4. Meriwether: Lewis's first name.
5. St. Louis: Lewis and Clark returned here two years later.
6. Great Joy: Clark's entry into his journal when they reached the Pacific.
7. Mandan Indians: Lewis and Clark spent their first winter with this tribe.
8. Sacajewea: The Shoshone woman who helped Lewis and Clark.
9. France: Purchased the Louisiana Territory from this country.
10. Maps: They created these for future travelers.
