4. _____ A student says that he tried to make a statement about what he thinks and if another student says "no comment" or "I don't know."

5. _____ A student gets out the answer when the teacher has asked a question. Student is asked a question.

6. _____ A student says that the teacher said "yes" and then the teacher said "no" and the student says "yes" again.

7. _____ A student is supposed to write a story with his group helping him write it, but he is writing on his own and not using the group.

8. _____ A student is doing homework for mathematics while at history class.

9. _____ A teacher comes to class and says "no".

10. _____ A student says that the teacher is asking a question about the class.

11. _____ A student is playing a game with his teacher and his classmates and is not listening to what the teacher is saying. The teacher has asked to stop the game.

12. _____ A teacher looks at the class when asked because they were all laughing.
