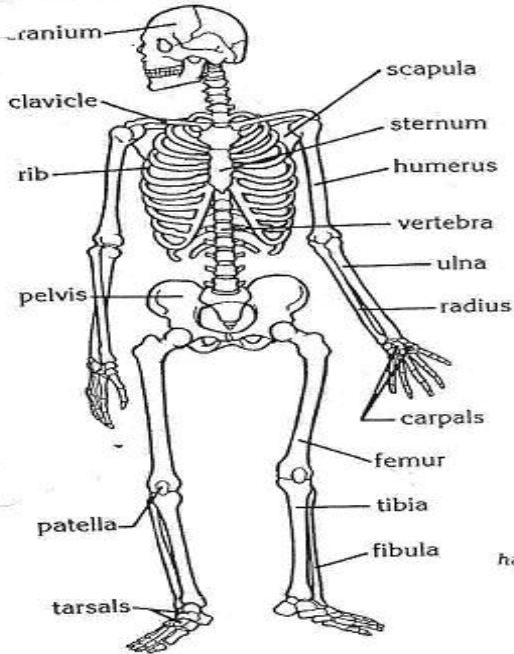
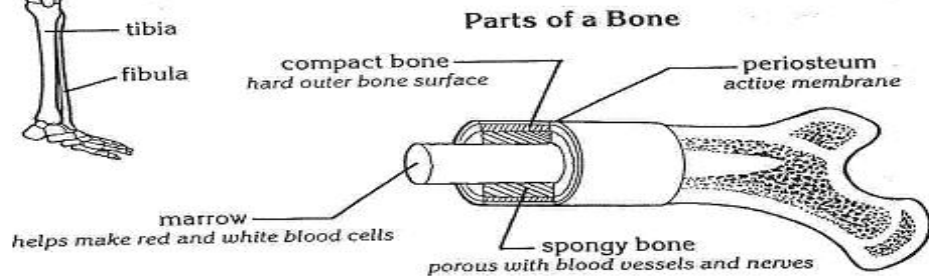


The Skeletal System
