Haiku

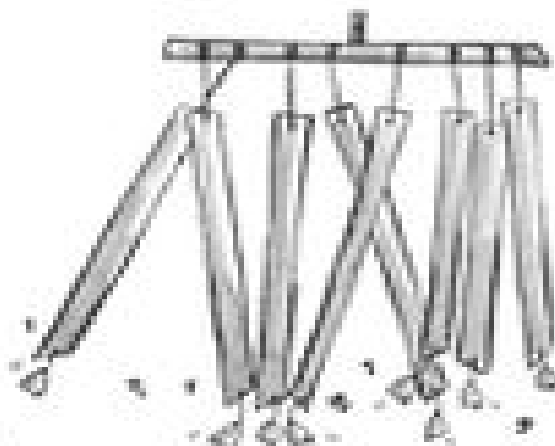
Poem in three lines:
