Suffixes: *ible/able*

A **suffix** is a letter or group of letters added to the end of a root or base word. A suffix changes the meaning of the word.

Suffixes : " **able**", " **ible**" - capable of or able to be; likely to; worthy of

Example: treatable = able to be treated
adorable = worthy of being adored
agreeable = likely to agree
