

7TH GRADE BEHAVIOR CONTRACT



#1: RESPECT YOURSELF:

- ⊗ Come to class prepared to learn and bring the required materials to class because you will **NOT** be allowed to “borrow” supplies from a classmate.
- ⊗ Do the homework! You’re expected to complete it by the time it’s due—**NO LATE WORK** will be allowed unless you’ve been given an extension for an absence. Missed homework assignments will result in a homework card write-up, letters/phone calls home, and/or homework club after school with me.
- ⊗ Focus on your improvement & challenge yourself to do your best—each small accomplishment adds up!

#2: RESPECT YOUR CLASS:

- ⊗ Be a professional scholar in this class! Shouting out or making inappropriate comments during class time is completely unacceptable. Constant talking or distracting others from learning is immature and will not be tolerated.
- ⊗ Support & encourage your classmates. We will work towards shared & individual goals this year and we will only succeed if we all contribute & work together. Learn when to actively listen & when to speak up.
- ⊗ Respect our class environment and keep it positive! Do not damage textbooks, treat class materials with care, don’t draw or doodle on any assignments that you know you’ll be turning in!

#3: RESPECT YOUR TEACHER:

- ⊗ Show me that you know how to act like an adult and you’ll be treated like one! If you like freedom and independence, you’ll get it only if you can demonstrate that you know how to act mature in a classroom. Privileges will be given and taken away according to your behavior, so make good choices.

Consequences:

- **1st Strike:** a 15-minute **DETENTION**. You must get a parent/guardian signature on the slip in order to serve the detention, and you must serve the detention on the assigned date. Do **NOT** lose it.
- **2nd Strike:** If you do **NOT** serve the 15-minute detention, or you have broken a rule for the 2nd time, you will automatically receive a 30-minute **DETENTION** with parent notification.
- **3rd Strike:** If you do not serve your 30-minute detention, you will be assigned a **REFERRAL** to the office which will then result in a Central Detention or Saturday School. By this point, I will ask your parent to meet with me personally in a conference.
