

**Apostrophes Worksheet**  
**ANSWER KEY**

The following sentences contain possessives, contractions, and other minor problems that require apostrophes. Review your notes to remember the rules for placing apostrophes, and correct the following sentences accordingly. **Each sentence only contains one problem.** Remember to also practice writing imitation sentences in preparation for the quiz!

1. **Whos** the candidate for vice president this year?

**Who's** (contraction for who is)

2. The fox had its right foreleg caught securely in the **traps** jaws.

**trap's** (the jaws of the trap – trap is singular possessive)

3. Our **neighbors** car is an old Chrysler.

**neighbor's** (the car of the neighbor – neighbor is singular possessive)

4. **Didnt** you hear that he is leaving tomorrow?

**Didn't** (contraction for did not)

5. She did not hear her **childrens** cries.

**children's** (the cries of the children – children is plural possessive without an s)
