An interview with sensitivity



Lesson plan

One person is chosen to leave the room. Within groups, this person must think of three questions they'd like to ask someone in order to get to know them better (for example: their school movement, what hobby they'd most like to have, favorite food), reflect they think their best quality is, who within they are out of the room, each learner is given a piece of paper and told to do that task during their "interview". Most of the learners will get to see which the other person said about them and then talk with the presenting in communication barrier of income used.

The person asking the questions will not know what the class is doing until after the final interview.

After each round of questions, the class will discuss what happened and the interviewer will provide thoughts on how it might be improved.
