

Exclamatory sentences

Exclamatory sentences are used to show your surprised feeling and you say things suddenly without any long time of thought!

Study the examples below

1. what a handsome man!
2. What an expensive computer!
3. What handsome people!
4. What expensive computers!
5. What a handsome man he is!
6. what an expensive computer it is!
7. What handsome people they are!
8. what expensive computers they are!

Forms

1. What + a/an + adjective + singular +!
What a handsome man!
What an expensive computer!
or What + a/an + adjective + singular noun + subject + verb+!
What a handsome man he is!
What an expensive computer it is!
2. What + adjective + plural noun!
What handsome people!
What expensive computers!
or What + adjective + plural noun + subject + Verb
3. What + adjective + un-count noun +!
What hot weather it is!
What nice water it is!

Explanation

1. He is a very good student.
=>> What a good student!
=>> What a good student he is!
2. They have a very expensive house!
=>> What an expensive house!
=>> What an expensive house they have!
3. She is a very intelligent teacher.
=>> What an intelligent teacher!
=>> What an intelligent teacher she is!
4. She speaks Slow English.
=>> What slow English she speaks!
=>> How slow English!

Note: "!" is called "exclamative mark or "exclamation point".
