

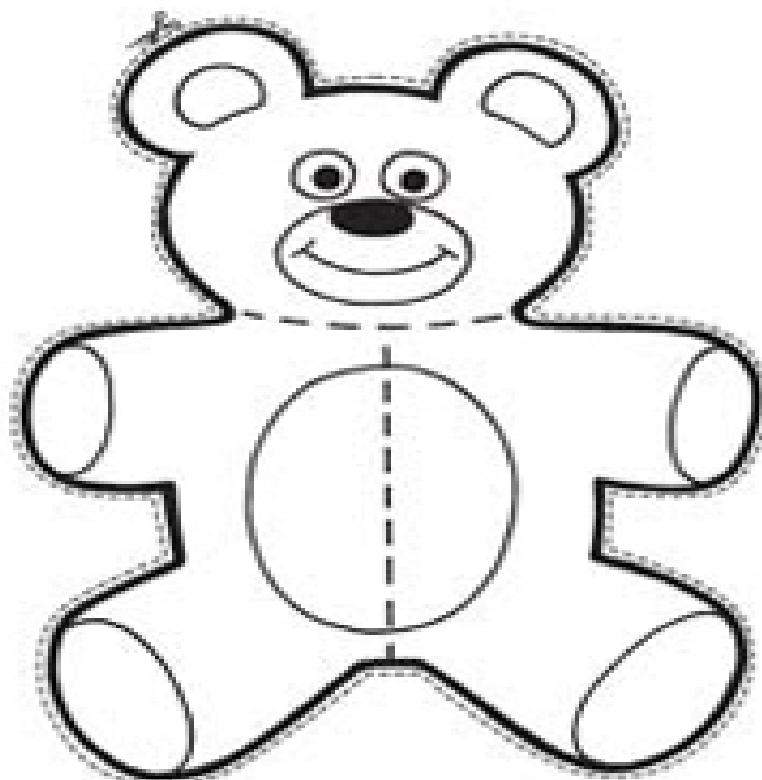
More Puzzle Practice

Cut out the puzzle below along the dotted lines. (You may wish to glue the pieces on poster board for easier handling.) As your baby assembles this puzzle, give lots of encouragement and assistance. Your baby's skill and coordination will increase the more he practices this activity.



Purchase some simple wooden puzzles for your baby. Then take the time to sit with your baby and show him how to assemble a puzzle, one piece at a time. Encourage your little learner to assemble the puzzle himself. Keep adding more challenging puzzles to his puzzle collection.
