1. ACCIDENT REPORTING

Accidents at work - no matter how small - must be reported immediately to your supervisor and the EHS Department. Serious accidents must be reported immediately to the EHS Department.

2. GENERAL SAFETY RULES FOR ALL EMPLOYEES

It is the responsibility of all employees to follow the following safety rules:

- Always use proper safety procedures and techniques for the job.
- In case of a fire or explosion, evacuate the area immediately. Do not return to the area until authorized by the EHS Department.
- In case of a spill, notify the EHS Department immediately. Do not attempt to clean up the spill unless authorized by the EHS Department.
- Do not wear loose clothing or jewelry around machinery. Do not wear loose clothing and jewelry around machinery.
- Never drink or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs while working. Do not drink or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs while working.
- When required, use proper personal protective equipment (PPE) such as safety glasses, masks, gloves, earplugs, etc.
- Safety equipment such as ladders, scaffolds, and other equipment should be inspected for proper use before each use.
