

Human Skeleton Worksheet



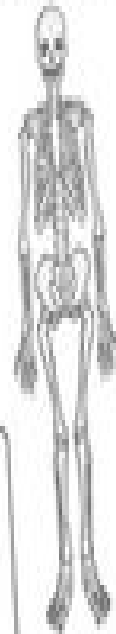

The body is made up of many bones called the skeleton. Bones are mainly made up of calcium. The skeleton protects the soft inner parts of the body. Muscles pull on parts of the skeleton to make the body move. A joint is where two bones meet. Some joints allow parts of the skeleton to bend. The skeleton provides the body with support and gives it its shape.

Draw arrows to the correct part of the skeleton and label it.

- A. This bone protects the brain.
- B. These bones protect the lungs.
- C. This bone protects the heart.
- D. This joint allows the leg to bend.
