# CALCULATING DOSAGE WORKSHEET

Maria gives you several prescriptions for you to practice using the formula to calculate the dosage. Make sure you include the correct form (g, mg, mL, etc.) when making your calculations. The first one has been set up for you. Note: If the quantity (Q) is larger than 1, you may want to simplify (cancel) before multiplying.

$$\text{Dosage formula: } \frac{D}{H} \times Q = \text{one dose}$$

1. Order: 500 mg  
Supply on hand: 250 mg per tablet

1. Order: 1 g  
Supply on hand: 0.5 g per capsule

1. Order: 50 mg  
Supply on hand: 25 mg per 5 mL

1. Order: 1000 mg  
Supply on hand: 2000 mg per scored tablet

1. Order: 500 mg  
Supply on hand: 125 mg per caplet

1. Order: 250 mg  
Supply on hand: 125 mg per capsule

1. Order: 25 mg  
Supply on hand: 100 mg per 20 mL
