

#### VERBS WITH PREPOSITIONS

a. 'about' indicates the subject matter: เกี่ยวกับ

worry, complain, do, dream, explain, hear, know, speak, talk, think, write

b. 'at' indicates direction: ที่

laugh, look, point, shoot, shout, smile, stare

c. 'for' indicates purpose or reason: สำหรับ/เพื่อ/เพื่อ

apologize, apply, ask, leave, look, search, wait

d. 'into' indicates the object involved in a collision: กระทบ/พุ่ง/ไป

bump, crash, drive, run

e. 'of' indicates facts of information:

hear, know, speak, talk, think

f. 'on' indicates confidence or certainty:

congratulate, count, depend, plan, rely

g. 'to' indicates the listener or reader: ไปถึง

complain, explain, listen, say, speak, talk, write

h. 'with' indicates someone whose opinion is the same or different: กับ

agree, argue, disagree, side

4. Some verbs have an object, but are also followed by a preposition.
