He was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, on August 6, 1928. He began exhibiting his work during the 1950s. It was during the 1960s that Warhol began to make paintings of iconic American products such as Campbell's Soup Cans and Coca-Cola bottles, as well as paintings of celebrits such as Marilyn Monroe, Elvis Presley, Troy Donahue, Muhammad Ali and Elizabeth Taylor. founded "The Factory," his studio, during these years, and socialized with lots of artists, write musicians, and underground celebrities. Warhol died in his sleep from a sudden post-operative cardiac arrhythmia after a blade surgery, on February 22, 1987. at the age of $58$ .	ler
