



Elements of Art – Texture

All objects have texture, but it can be a challenge for artist to recreate the texture in two-dimensional art. *Tactile texture* is texture that you can feel and *visual texture* is texture you can see. Since we can't touch the art, we will focus on visual texture. Texture in a two-dimensional artwork is created with color, line, shading, and brush strokes. Personal experiences add to the experience of texture when looking at art because you don't need to actually touch the art to have an idea of what the objects would feel like.
