

K is for Koinobori

Koinobori are fish-shaped flags flown in Japan on Children's Day. Children's Day is a holiday just for kids! Every kid is special, and on Children's Day, Japan celebrates the happiness of kids.

You can make your own koinobori! Color the pattern, cut it out, and follow the directions below.

Directions: Here's how you can help:

1. Cut out the whole shape along outside line.
2. Punch hole in the center of the top of the fish head.
3. Curl into a cylinder shape, and smooth flap to underside to hold in place.
4. Tie string through hole, and smooth to stick, pencil, or other object.
