

BRAIN RING

Game rules:

1. Students are divided into groups of 4-6.
2. Choosing the captain.
3. First only members are invited to the game, the proposed answers questions and other ones (if the answer is right).
4. Decide which team is the first and then their captain picks up the number of questions for himself.
5. When the question is read, the team has 30 seconds to discuss and give the answer.
6. If the answer is correct the captain gets a point. If not, the other team can answer the question and get a point.
7. In case that the team answers another team's question correctly they have to continue the game and their captain starts.
8. When the 2 minutes are over, the captain suggests the judge what the result is and chooses the winner.
9. In order to be honest, the team shouldn't discuss and their answer as they get the question - opportunities to their total score.
10. Each member should have the opportunity to answer, but they can choose to answer the captain only. But there will be such a rule that one captain's mistakes can answer without discussing with his team members, even if he or she is not alone in answering them.
11. If there are more than 2 teams, each team should play the game in order to be the first and choose the most intelligent player.
