A **conjunction** is a word that is used to combine sentences, phrases, or words. The three most common conjunctions are "and", "but", and "or".

Two simple sentences: Ali wanted to go skateboarding with his friends.
It was raining outside.

One compound sentence: Ali wanted to go skateboarding with his friends, but it was raining outside.
