## Which Word Works?

Practice choosing the correct verb for the sentence.

Read the paragraphs below and select the correct words.

Alexander Graham Bell (**is/were**) born in Scotland. His mother (**is/was**) deaf and his father (**teach/taught**) the deaf how to speak, so Bell always (**had/have**) an interest in the mechanics of speech and in (**worked/working**) with the deaf himself. As a teen, he (**creates/created**) a machine that cried "mama," using the voice box of a dead sheep. When Bell was a young man, his father (**moved/moving**) the family to Canada. A couple of years later, Bell moved to Boston, where he eventually (**become/became**) a professor at Boston University. He (**marry/married**) Mabel Hubbard, who had been one of his students and was deaf. After accidentally (**hearing/heard**) the sound of a plucked need over the telegraph wire, Bell (**work/worked**) with his associate, Thomas Watson, on creating the first telephone. On February 14, 1876, he (**applied/apply**) for a patent on his telephone. Bell had other inventions, too, such as a breathing lung made of iron and a device for (**locating/locate**) icebergs at sea. He also helped create the National Geographic Society and was its president for many years.

The Cabinet (**is/was**) a group of people that the president of the United States (**appointing/appoints**) as trusted advisors when he or she (**taking/takes**) office. Cabinet appointees must be (**approved/approving**) by a majority vote of the U.S. Senate. The Cabinet (**include/includes**) the vice president, fifteen heads of executive branches, and various other governmental officials. Some important Cabinet members (**is/are**) the secretary of state, who (**work/works**) with foreign countries; the secretary of the treasury, who is in charge of the collection of taxes; the secretary of defense, who (**oversee/s/overseeing**) the armed forces; and the attorney general, who (**enforce/s/enforced**) the laws of the U.S. government. The Cabinet (**serve/serves**) for as long as the president is in office.
