

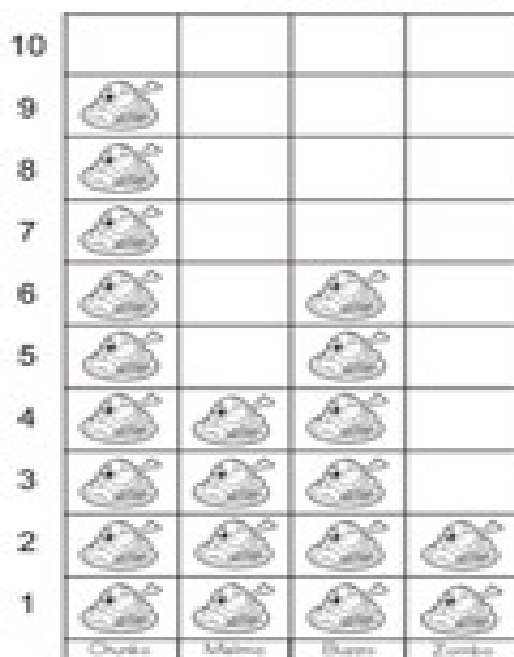
## Fabulous Feasting!

Analyzing a pictograph
