



VERBS IN TRANSIT

the object is required.

AMBITRANSITIVE




She walks.



He walks the dog.


The dog is optional,
as are other objects.
The verb works either way.

INTRANSITIVE



He swims.

The verb doesn't use an object.
An object would be silly.
