

**How to Make the Sound: /l/ & /r/**

To make the /l/ sound, *place the tip of your tongue behind your upper, front teeth*. Your breath should pass through the sides of your tongue and lips.

To make the /r/ sound, *place the tip of your tip of your tongue further back and the tip of your tongue must not touch the roof of your mouth*.
