Where can we find grasslands? Most grasslands grow between forests and deserts. Grasslands are flat, open and windy. It is warm in summer, but it can be very cold in winter.

Many animals, including horses, gazelles, rhinos, hippos and lions live in groups for their protection. Leopards, cheetahs, snakes and vultures also live in the grasslands. Millions of insects such as grasshoppers, beetles, ants and termites live among the tall grasses.
