

A Welcome

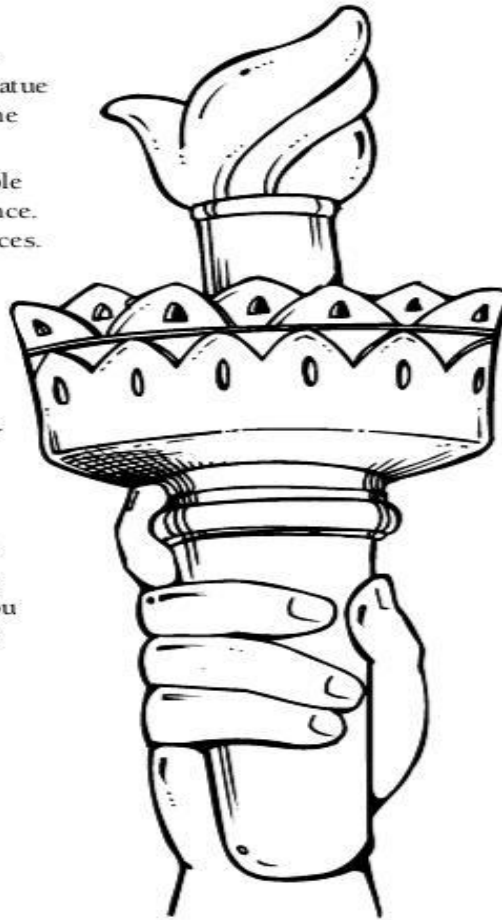
It's nice to feel welcome when you go to a strange place.
