## Measuring Tornadoes

How do scientists measure a tornado?

They use a scale that is based on wind speed.

The scale tells how much damage a tornado could cause.



Read the speed on each tornado.  
Use the Tornado Scale.  
Write the rating on the line.

Tornado Scale		
Wind Speed	Rating	Damage
40–55 mph	F0	Light damage
55–70 mph	F1	Moderate damage
70–90 mph	F2	Considerable damage
90–110 mph	F3	Severe damage
110–160 mph	F4	Devastating damage
160–200 mph	F5	Incredible damage
