Interrogative- asks a question. It is followed by a question mark.

Exclamatory- shows excitement or expresses strong feeling. It is followed by an exclamation point.

Declarative- makes a statement. It is always followed by a period.

Imperative- gives a command or makes a request. It is usually followed by a period. A strong command is followed by an exclamation point.
