

## Identify the Homographs

Homographs



Homographs are words that have the exact same spelling, but different meanings. Sometimes they are pronounced differently, and sometimes the pronunciation is the same. It is important to use context clues to decode the meaning and pronunciation of the word.

Word Bank: match, letter, light, object, perfect  
parent, procedure, conduct, contact, pitch

Read the definitions, then write the appropriate homograph from the word bank on each line.

1. A slender piece of wood or cardboard tipped with flammable chemicals, that burns if it is exposed to flame; something that resembles a torch, such as a bonfire, flames, fireworks, or something.
2. Physical behavior; to head or guide (an animal) back to safety by use of a stick, etc.
3. Move forward or onward, especially after stopping; the total amount received from a sale or investment.
4. A unit of measurement equal to three feet; the ground that is next to and surrounding a house or other building.
5. A competition between rivals; to argue against.
6. To allow to do something; an official certificate or license of permission.
7. Something that makes things visible; an illumination; to set to burning; to brighten up with joy; having fewer calories.
8. Inclined or complete the climb from the need of a certain situation; to bring to completion or make fully known.
9. A thing that can be seen or observed; its return to permit.
10. A written communication sent from one person to another; an award given for excellence in sports, a symbol of other abilities.
