- An **interval** is the distance between two notes. Being able to identify intervals quickly will greatly improve your skills at reading music. Below are explanations and examples of the intervals we learned about so far:

| Unison | 2nd | 3rd | 4th | 5th |
| When a note is repeated, the interval is called a unison. | Two notes just a step apart are called a 2nd. | Two notes that are a skip apart are called a 3rd. | 4ths are a step bigger than a 3rd. | 5ths can be played comfortably on the piano using fingers 1 and 5. |
