Level ONE	<p><u>Rainbow Spiral</u></p> <p>Write each word in a different color, creating a spiral, from the inside going outwards</p>	<p><u>Chalk It Up</u></p> <p>Write your words on the driveway or sidewalk in 3 different colors using sidewalk chalk</p>	<p><u>Trace Your Words</u></p> <p>Trace your words in sand, in shaving cream, on felt, or on the carpet</p>
Level TWO	<p><u>Vowels and Consonants</u></p> <p>Write your words using one color for vowels and another color for consonants</p>	<p><u>Triangle Spelling</u></p> <p>Write your words in triangles. Example: t th the them</p>	<p><u>Ransom Words</u></p> <p>Choose your 5 hardest words. Cut out letters to make up each word and glue them down on a piece of paper.</p>
Level THREE	<p><u>Top Ten</u></p> <p>Choose the 10 most important words that you think every student should know. Rank them from 1-10.</p>	<p><u>Stick Figures</u></p> <p>Choose at least 8 words and create stick figure pictures showing what your words mean.</p>	<p><u>Practice Test</u></p> <p>Have mom or dad give you a practice test. Write each incorrect word 3 times each. Have your parent initial.</p>
Level FOUR	<p><u>Money Alphabet</u></p> <p>If A=\$1, B=\$2, how much is each spelling word worth?</p>	<p><u>Create Your Own</u></p> <p>Create your own fun way to practice your spelling words. Practice it and share it with your teacher.</p>	<p><u>Class Story</u></p> <p>Write a story using all of your spelling words and include students from your class</p>
