



Tornadoes

A tornado is a rotating, funnel-shaped cloud that can cause winds up to 200 miles per hour!

During a typical tornado, the sky turns dark and hailstones fall.

Below are the definitions of a tornado watch and a tornado warning.

If a tornado watch is issued for your community, it means the conditions are right for a tornado to develop. Listen to the radio or watch TV to see if the weather gets worse.

If a tornado warning is issued, it means a tornado has been sighted and you should go to your safe place immediately.
