| <b>beneath</b>     | in a lower place; under; below (PREPOSITION)   |
| <b>buried</b>      | covered up; hidden(VERB)   |
| <b>chimney</b>     | a tall, hollow column, usually made of brick, to carry away smoke from a fireplace or furnace(NOUN)                            |
| <b>earthquakes</b> | violent shaking or shifting motion of the ground caused by the sudden movement of rock far beneath Earth's surface(NOUN)       |
| <b>fireworks</b>   | firecrackers and other things that make a loud noise or go up high in the air and burst in a shower of stars and sparks (NOUN) |
| <b>force</b>       | power; strength (NOUN)   |
| <b>trembles</b>    | moves with a quick shaking motion (VERB)   |
| <b>volcanoes</b>   | hills or mountains built up by lava and ash around an opening in Earth's crust (NOUN)  |
| <b>authorities</b> | the officials in control (NOUN)  |
| <b>debris</b>      | scattered pieces or bits of something that has been torn down or blown up (NOUN)   |
| <b>evacuate</b>    | to get everyone out of a dangerous place or situation(VERB)  |
