

Homework Policy: Students are expected to have a full week of time for homework. The student has three days including the day of school to complete make-up assignments if they were given during the student's absence. If the assignment is not made up within the three days, and the student has not been in communication with the teacher, the student will receive an F grade. Make-ups will be offered during break or by special arrangement. Students must not reschedule the make-up of a quiz/test, essay or assignment. The student is expected to have prior work with teacher on the day of absence. If a student is absent and has no open class, tests/assignments take it. It is a privilege to find a study buddy to go toward assignments and to seek guidance/best work. Always share the **Best assignment responses** available or handwritten for assignments and bestwork on the day of class. All long-term assignments and open class assignments are listed on **Google Classroom**. Long-term and projects will be assigned and in advance of their due dates. Therefore, student is well be expected to have them done by their due date regardless of absence. I will not accept them late. This covers being responsible and planning ahead. Need it with a friend, get it to someone to have it delivered to the office or it's due date and have it rescheduled.

Reading Policy: The student's grade in this course will be determined by the following:

- **Judgments:** Five (5) individual written assignments including journal responses, student goals, research, reading response questions, and various formative assignments.
- **Vocabulary/Spelling:** The part of the grade is based on weekly vocabulary and spelling tests.
- **Opinion/Book:** The part of the grade is based on writing opinion and book or the **Non-fiction** assignments. Final grade will be given at the end of the semester.
- **Essay/Reading Projects:** The part value for this part of the grade will be given in advance for each assignment.
- **Participation:** Student will receive participation points each month. Student will receive one point for everything they are involved, prepared with all necessary materials, spelling questions, and getting them right. Community time of participation of the student design class is family friendly rules will be followed. Being disruptive, talking, or focus on task not being respectful towards others.

Individual Integrity: Students shall not plagiarize assignments, quizzes, writing, research assignments, or "homework" in their own words they must be fully the work of the student. If such cheating occurs, an automatic zero will replace any score and the student will leave the class until a verbal "I am sorry" reflection of the code will need to occur from the class with a failing grade. Therefore, that failing a class is considered cheating.
