The car	→ ARTICLE
The gold fish	→ POSSESSIVE
The old black horse	→ COLOUR, AGE, TYPE
Some good old university	→ ADJ. + NOUN
The old car	→ AGE + NOUN
Some good horses	→ ADJ. + NOUN + NOUN

ARTICLES: There are 3 TYPES OF ARTICLES

<p>1. Indefinite articles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - are used to say what something or somebody is EXAMPLES: This is a book. Look! It's a chicken. He is a student. - It refers to things or a person for the first time EXAMPLES: She lives in a farmhouse. He fell down with a pencil. I bought a pair of shoes today. - It refers to things or a person when it doesn't matter which one EXAMPLES: Cook your food the quick!
