



## For your eyes only



When did you last have an eye test? One in three adults in the UK fails to have a regular eye test and, in doing so, is putting their eyesight at risk. Many women spend a fortune on eye make-up products but neglect the important thing - the eye itself.

Having an eye test every two years is not very expensive (£10 to £40) and many people can get their eyes tested free. Eye tests are free for everyone in Scotland but, in the rest of the UK, free tests are given only to those who are under 19 and in full-time education and to anyone over 60. There is also no charge for an eye test for people with diabetes or glaucoma, or for those who receive certain state benefits.



If you use a VDU (computer screen) at work, your employer must pay for regular check-ups and the cost of a basic pair of glasses if you need them specifically for work.

Don't make the mistake that many people do by just going into a shop and buying a pair of reading glasses for a couple of pounds. You should regularly get a proper eye test lasting 20 to 30 minutes.
