- The correct order you work out a math problem

• Remember by "PEMDAS"

Please Excuse My DEAR Aunt Sally.....

What is the order? PEMDAS

1. P - parenthesis - do what's inside first
2. E - exponents/powers next
3. M/D - multiplication/division from left \rightarrow right
4. A/S - addition/subtraction from left \rightarrow right

Example

	$3(6 + 2^2) \div 15 + 5$
P	$3(\underline{6 + 2^2}) \div 15 + 5$
E	$3(6 + \underline{4}) \div 15 + 5$
M	$\underline{3(10)} \div 15 + 5$
D	$\underline{30 \div 15} + 5$
A	$2 + 5$
