<p>To Show Place or Location <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>Above, across, adjacent to, around, behind, below, beside, beyond, close to, far from, nearby, opposite to, over, under, left, on the right</p>
<p>To Show Time <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>After, as soon as, before, during, earlier, immediately, in the future, later, meanwhile, once, until, when</p>
<p>To Show Sequence (order) <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>Again, finally, first, next, second, soon, subsequently, then, third</p>
<p>To Show Similarity <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>In the same way, in the same manner, like, likewise, similarly</p>
<p>To Show Differences <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>Although, but, even though, however, in contrast, nevertheless, on the other hand, whereas, whereas, yet</p>
<p>To Add Information <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>Again, also, besides, furthermore, in addition, moreover</p>
<p>To Show Cause and Effect <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>As a result, because, consequently, for this reason, since, therefore, thus</p>
<p>To Introduce Examples <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>For example, for instance, namely, to illustrate</p>
<p>To Conclude or Summarize <i>Connectives</i></p>	<p>As a result, finally, in conclusion, in brief, in summary, therefore</p>
