- 6. **Conceptual** relating to or characterized by ideas for things that have particular PROPERTIES, describe something that is general in nature
- 7. **Concept** an abstract or general idea or notion
- 8. **Out of the world** to be very good or excellent, to be greatly admired
- 9. **Out there** outside or away from the very beginning, far from anything
- 10. **To picture** picture **abstract** words mean that a concept or idea is not a simple representation of reality, but is a complex idea
